



## Plant Your Keys Here!

Organize your life, and beautify it all at once! This design has multiple parts. There is a basket, loose leaves, and the actual plant design that will be sewn onto the fabric. Put them all together, and the best part is that you won't even have to water it!

### Sewing Supplies:

Two pieces of outer fabric 8" x 13 1/2"

Two pieces of cotton batting 8" x 13 1/2"



One "4" Hook Organizer Rail available from Home Depot

Black Tear-A-Way Stabilizer

Brown or black Organza

Assorted Rayon Embroidery Threads

Two binding strip 2" wide x the width of the fabric

14" wide Steam-A-Seam 2

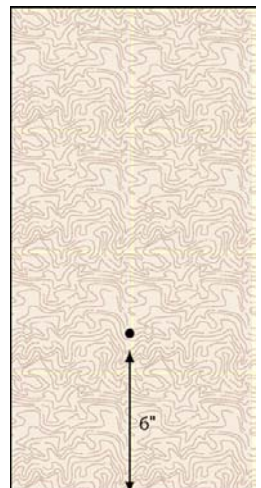
Fasturn Tube

1. Hoop brown or black organza with black Tear-A-Way Stabilizer underneath.
2. Select the basket design. Stitch the basket design.
3. Remove from the hoop, and trim away the excess fabric. You can use a stencil cutter to get close to the stitches if desired.
4. Hoop black Tear-A-Way and brown or black organza. Wind a bobbin with green rayon embroidery thread. Stitch the loose leaf design.
5. Remove from the hoop, and trim away the excess fabric. You can use a stencil cutter to get close to the stitches if desired.
6. On the 8" x 13 1/2" outer piece, mark the embroidery start point 6" up from the bottom as shown.
7. Embroider the plant. Colors 1 through 7 are the plant. Color 8 traces



the placement of the basket. After the machine stops after color 8, put the basket in place. Color 9 will stitch the basket down. When the embroidery is complete, place a small piece of Steam-A-Seam 2 in the basket. Insert the loose leaves and steam, to fuse them in place.

8. Above the plant, using the Palace Script Font Disk, or one of your choice, embroider the words: Plant your keys here.
9. Place the embroidered front piece wrong sides together with the backing piece. Place two layers of cotton batting between the two. Straight stitch close to the edge. Trim if necessary to square them up.
10. Press the binding strips in half, wrong sides together.
11. Sew binding to sides first, placing the binding on the wrong side of the wall hanging. Fold to the right side, and stitch in place with F11. Before applying the binding to the top and bottom, turn ends under, to finish. Stitch to the wrong side, then bring to the front, as before.

12. Cut two binding strips, each 6" long. Fold right sides together and stitch, using a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn using a Fasturn Tube. Press. Thread through the holes in the Key Holder.

13. Bring the ends together. Place on the wall hanging, underneath the plant, turn under the ends, and stitch in place.



14. To hang the key holder, stitch buttonholes in the upper corners. Hang from cup hooks or decorative hooks.
