Sewing Supplies:

Husqvarna Viking Sewing/Embroidery Machine
 1 yard Gold Tone on Tone Fabric for Runner
 1/2 yard Print for Border
 Sewing Thread
 Inspira Tear-A-Way Light Stabilizer # 141000820
 Scarecrow Design
 Assorted 40 wt. Robison Anton or Sulky Rayon
 Embroidery Threads
 Clear 1/4" Piecing Foot with Guide #412927445
 Fasturn Tube Turner #140000001
 1/4" wide Steam-A-Seam 2 #140000195
 Spanish Hem Stitch Foot and Plate

Cut:

From Gold Tone on Tone

Two pieces 10" x 43"

Eight squares 3" x 3"



From Print for Border

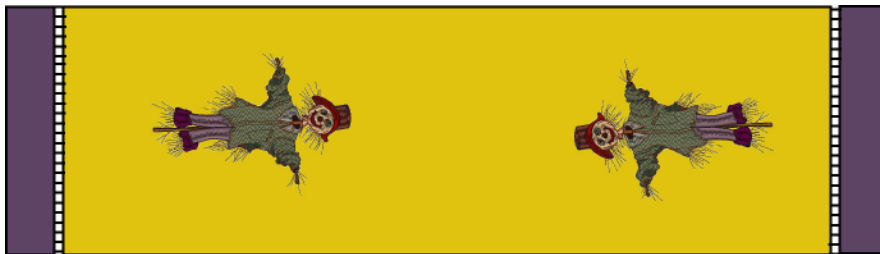
Five strips 3" x width of fabric cut into four strips 3" x 43" and four strips 3" x 10"

1. Embroider the scarecrow on each end of the runner approximately 2 1/2" from the ends.
2. Place two strips 3" x 43" right sides together. Snap on your Clear 1/4" Piecing Foot with Guide. Stitch around the strips leaving a 3" opening for turning.
3. Repeat for the remaining strips and the 3" x 3" squares.



4. Clip the corners and turn, using your Fasturn Tube Turner. Press.

5. Place the embroidered runner right sides together with the lining and stitch, leaving a 4" opening to turn. Clip the corners, turn and press.
6. Insert Steam-A-Seam 2 in the opening on all the pieces and press to fuse.
7. All your pieces are now finished on all sides. You are ready to attach them together, using the Spanish Hemstitch foot and plate.
8. Attach your Spanish Hemstitch Foot and Plate. Bring up the bobbin thread by tapping your foot control twice so the needle goes down, then up. Select E15 . Touch the FIX button to deactivate it. Place one gold square next to the end of one of the 3" x 43" strips. Holding the threads as you begin, stitch the pieces together.
9. Touch Pattern Restart  to bring the stitch back to the beginning. Repeat with a gold square at the other end. Repeat with the other 3" x 43" strip and remaining squares.
10. Stitch the 10" x 43" to each end of the embroidered center.



11. Then stitch the side strips in place.
