

## Halloween Denim Shirt



Get into the Halloween spirit with this “batty” denim shirt. Tight on time—just purchase a denim shirt and stitch out the appliques included with HOLIDAY SCRAPBOOKING by MACHINE. It’s just spooky!

**Supplies:**

Purchased denim shirt  
1/4 yard of lame fabric  
Tear-away stabilizer  
Temporary spray adhesive  
Water- and air-soluble marking pen

**Directions:**

1. After transferring your designs into the appropriate embroidery format for your machine, set your embroidery sewing machine for embroidery.
2. It is always wise to stitch a sample of the designs you would like to use first for sizing and placement. Trace the design onto the embroidery template that came with your machine. You have six Halloween embroidery or applique designs to choose from on the CD-ROM that comes with HOLIDAY SCRAPBOOKING by MACHINE.
3. Using the template, mark the desired placement of the embroideries on the shirt back and/or front.
4. Place the tear away stabilizer in the hoop and lightly spray with the adhesive. Place the area of the shirt to be embroidered, wrong side down, on the stabilizer.
5. Layer the lame fabric on top and embroider the bat as shown following the instructions on page 39-41 of HOLIDAY SCRAPBOOKING by MACHINE.



6. Embroider stars and a moon around the bat for a quick, scary shirt for your Halloween party. Add more appliques or embroideries to the front and sleeves if desired. Stitch out "BOO!" using the Quick Fonts Plus software and you're all set for Trick or Treating.
