

Polar Fleece Scarf



All it takes is a funny snowman to brighten up this cozy polar fleece scarf. Add embroidered snowflakes to your design, then choose either embroidery or applique to make your snowman.

Supplies:

12"-wide X 40" – 50" long piece of polar fleece

12" square each of white polar fleece and white-on-white cotton fabric

Cut-away stabilizer

Temporary spray adhesive
Husqvarna Viking embroidery card #38, Christmas by Natalie Sorenson
Mega Hoop (360X 150)
Chalk marker

Directions:

1. Turn under 1/2" along each long edge of the polar fleece. Stitch down using a zig zag or blanket stitch.
2. Mark the placement for the snowflakes and snowman approximately 8" from each end of the scarf.
3. After transferring your design from the CD-ROM into the appropriate embroidery format for your machine, set your machine for embroidery and select the snowman applique design. Position and save the design in your embroidery machine.
4. Insert Husqvarna Viking embroidery card #38 and select the snowflake design, #27. Position two snowflakes above the snowman, viewing them on the machine screen as you work.
5. Place the stabilizer in the hoop and spray with the adhesive. Place the polar fleece, wrong side down, in the hoop centering the fabric using the marks.
6. First layer the white-on-white cotton fabric and then the white polar fleece on top of the scarf. Applique in place, trimming the fabrics and changing the thread colors as necessary following the color sequence chart on page 119 of HOLIDAY SCRAPBOOKING by MACHINE.
7. Or stitch out the snowman as a complete embroidery changing threads as advised.



8. Remove the scarf and carefully trim away the stabilizer from the back.
9. Cut fringe into each end by making 2 1/2" long cuts 1/2" apart.
