Golf Club Cover-Ups

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Make these great Club covers for
the golfer in your life! They'll love them!

Sewing Supplies

Polar fleece fabric

Felt for lining

Optional: Husqvarna Viking font disk/d-Card for

Designer I or II or Husqvarna Viking

Card 21 for use with #1+ or Rose

Felt for applique letter

Sulky or Robison Anton 40 wt. Embroidery Thread

Sulky Solvy or America Sews Water Soluble Stabilizer

Sewing thread to match fabric

Cut:

For each club cover:

2 fleece pieces from pattern

2 felt pieces from pattern

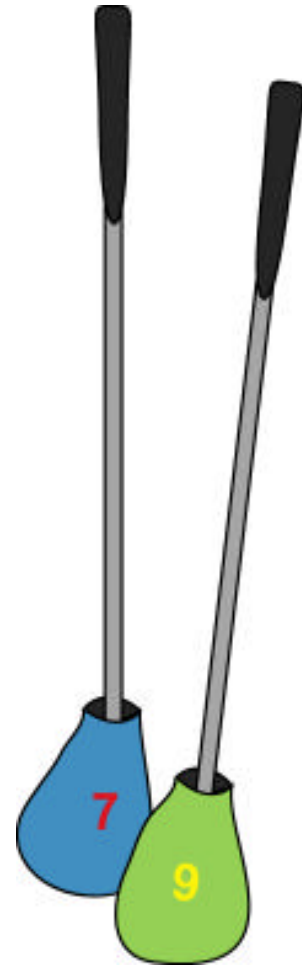
1 fleece gusset 3" x 28"

1 felt gusset 3" x 28"

Optional Embroidery:

Choose the font of your choice from Designer embroidery disk/d-Card or Embroidery Card #21. Embroider the corresponding Club number on the right side of one fleece piece in the 30mm size. Use water soluble stabilizer and embroidery thread.

Optional Applique:



If you do not have an embroidery machine, cut the numbers from felt and applique them onto the fleece.

Sew:

All cover-ups are constructed in the same manner. The outer cover is created separate from the lining piece. Align the end of the gusset with the bottom of the first fleece piece, right sides together. Stitch around the piece using a 1/2" seam allowance, easing fit in the curve. Attach other fleece piece to the other side of the gusset in the same manner. Clip curve and turn right side out. Create felt lining for the cover-ups in the same manner. Clip, but do not turn completed lining piece. Trim entire lining piece 1" shorter than fleece piece.

Insert finished felt lining piece into completed fleece cover up. Fold 1' from the bottom edge of fleece to the inside and blind hem to catch the felt lining.
