

Name Tag



Sewing Supplies

- Husqvarna Viking Sewing machine
- Scraps of leather
- Clear plastic
- Craft knife
- Fabric glue
- Schmetz Stretch Needle or Topstitching Needle
- Husqvarna Viking Roller Foot (411 85 29-45)
- Husqvarna Viking cutting mat
- Stitch n'Ditch or Tear Away stabilizer™
- Eyelet Cutter (412 37 55-45)
- Pictogram pen (412 08 38-48)

CUT

Trace the flower template E on the wrong side of the leather. Cut out two flowers. Place the circle template C on the clear plastic. Cut out a circle 1/4" (6 mm) larger than the template. Cut a 16" (40 cm) long narrow tie band in leather.

SEW

To cut out an opening for the plastic "window" on one of the flowers, lay the flower on a rotary cutting mat and cut with the craft knife around the circle template as illustrated. Illustration A.

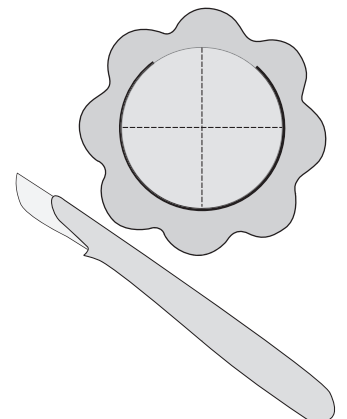

Place the flowers wrong sides together with plastic in between. Put a little fabric glue between the layers on each petal to hold while stitching. Be sure the glue is not in the area where you will be stitching.

Thread with heavy sewing thread on top and regular sewing thread in the bobbin. Use a stretch needle or a topstitching needle. Snap on the Roller Foot. Select straight stitch, stitch length 4.0. Loosen the thread tension a little. Place a piece of Stitch and Ditch or Tear Easy stabilizer underneath. Sew around the edge but leave an opening on top to insert the name. Illustration B.

Use the Eyelet Cutter to make a hole on top of the name tag. Thread the narrow tieband through the opening and tie the name tag to your suitcase.

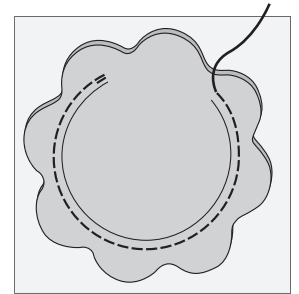
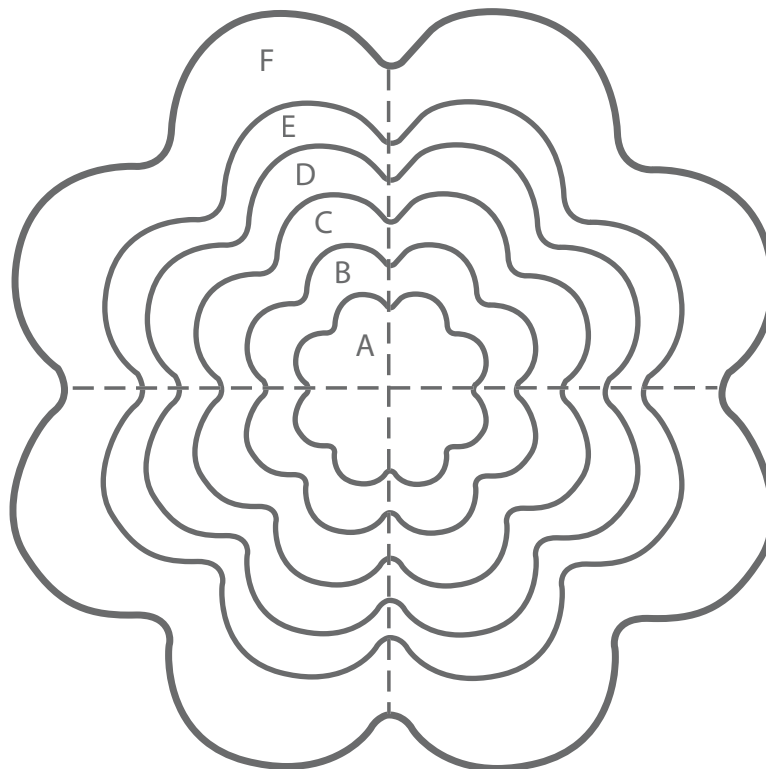
