

Baby hat

The baby hat does fit a small child of 4-6 month of age. Make it in a soft fleece, and as it is small you will only need some scraps or small piece of fabric. Follow the sewing instruction to create the little baby hat!

The hat can be sewn on any or your HUSQVARNA VIKING® sewing machine or if you prefer you can of course sew it on a HUSQVARNA VIKING® HUSKYLOCK™ machine.

Supplies

- HUSQVARNA VIKING® sewing machine and/ or HUSQVARNA VIKING® HUSKYLOCK™ machine
- Piece of Fleece or stretch fabric
- 2" (5 cm) stretch ribbing.
- Sewing thread
- Pins
- Scissor
- Rotary cutter/ cutting mat and ruler

1. Cut two pieces for the hat, seam allowance is included for the small size. With a fleece fabric you can cut it out in any direction. If you are using stretch you need to get the stretch around the head.
2. Cut out the dart in the pattern put the pattern over you two pieces and transfer the dart with a wash away fabric marker.
3. Sew the darts. Iron the dart towards the back of the hat.
4. If you are going to embroider on the hat, do that now. Or decorate the hat with a small appliqué or whatever you feel is nice to add.
5. Sew the long center seam.
6. Add a trimming around the hat. You can use any small piece of ribbing. Cut it the ribbing 2" (5cm) wide. The length should be slightly shorter than the edge of the hat. Stretch it and sew the ribbing to a tube.
7. Fold the ribbing lengthwise so that the finished width of the ribbing is one inch, (2.5cm) tube.
8. Pin the ribbing, on the right side of the hat, by dividing the length of the ribbing in four quarters, and pin at the right side edge of the hat. Start by putting a pin in the back of the hat, which is going to be the in the neck. That is where you should have the seam of the ribbing too. Do not forget to stretch it slightly.
9. Sew the ribbing in place, by using an seam and overcast seam. Follow the instruction on your Husqvarna Viking Sewing Advisor by selecting, Medium stretch then seam and overcast.
10. Put the hat on the baby, and enjoy the cold beautiful winter days!
