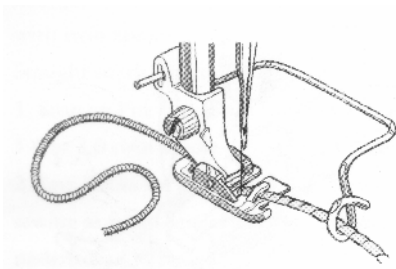


## Couching

There are many materials that can be used for couching! Try yarn, beads, rickrack and braids. There are different couching feet, and you need to use the appropriate couching foot for the fiber or bead that you are using. Always test the fiber or bead in the guide and/or groove on the foot to be sure it goes through the guide and under the foot freely. Here are some guidelines for the different feet and fibers.

### Gimping/Braiding Guide #412 55 44-45

This foot works very well with braids, mini Rick Rack and many yarns. We used it here for the “thick and thin” yarn. Sometimes, on the thick part, the yarn would work its way back to the needle opening as shown. That is fine.



When you reach the thin part, just re-insert it into the guide on the foot.

Thread with Sulky Invisible Thread on top and bobbin or sewing thread in the bobbin. Select the Stretch Stitch A1:5



. Thread the yarn from the top, through the opening and down under the back of the foot.



### 4mm Bead Foot #4127011-45

Thread with invisible thread on top and bobbin thread in the bobbin. Select A2:26, Stitch Width 2.5. Place pearls under the groove of the foot.
