

## Cutwork Bread Cloth

Cutwork designs are typically done tone on tone. Because you are cutting up to the edge of the stitching in some parts of the design, the cut edge will not be noticeable when the thread and fabric are the same color. If desired, you can use a contrast color thread. For our bread cloth, we used the same thread top and bobbin to make the cloth pretty on both sides, since both sides will be seen.




### Sewing supplies:

Husqvarna Viking **DESIGNER DIAMOND™**  
Husqvarna Viking Cutwork Finesse #202 Multifomat CD  
19" Square of Linen  
40 wt. Rayon Embroidery Thread to match Linen  
Inspira Aqua Magic Water Soluble Stabilizer  
Clear Open Toe Foot #413 03 19-45

1. Print templates of the design. We used design 3. Tape the templates together and “rough” cut them out.
2. Pin them to the fabric in the desired location.
3. Hoop two layers of Aqua Magic Water Soluble Stabilizer.
4. Bring up the design on your **DESIGNER DIAMOND™**.
5. Thread with 40 wt. rayon thread on top and in the bobbin. It is easiest if you wind three bobbins, which is what you should need, before you begin embroidering and have them ready to put in as needed.
6. Using the templates, pin the linen to the stabilizer. Touch Design Positioning 



7. Touch  Point One. Bring the cursor to the top center of the top flower on the Ultimate Interactive Screen.

8. Now, look at the hoop. The needle should be over the same spot on your template. Check one or two other spots by moving the cursor to different points in the design. If they don't match up, move the linen fabric and re-pin until they do.



9. Remove the template. Touch  to baste the linen in place.

10. Touch **START** **STOP** to begin embroidering. Your **DESIGNER DIAMOND™** will stitch the first color which traces the area to be cut out. When your machine stops, locate the areas to be trimmed by looking at the photographs in the design booklet. It makes it easier to mark the area that will be cut out with your Pictogram Pen.

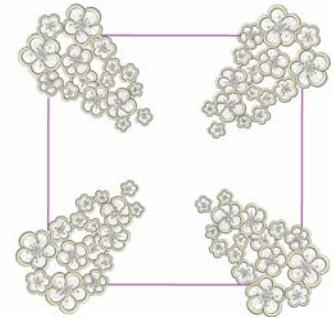


11. Cut the linen **ONLY** from the marked areas. Do **NOT** cut the stabilizer.

12. Finish the remainder of the embroidery.

13. Repeat the same steps for the other three embroideries.

14. Trim away as much of the stabilizer as you can. Using your Pictogram Pen, draw a line as shown, connecting the cutwork designs.



15. Toggle to Sewing 

16. Place strips of Aqua Magic Stabilizer underneath the purple lines. Select A1:28, the 4mm pre-programmed satin stitch.

17. Snap on your Clear Open Toe Foot and stitch along the lines.

18. Trim up to the stitching lines all the way around the outside of the bread cloth.

19. Soak to remove the remaining stabilizer.

20. Starch and press. Place in basket with yummy rolls!
