



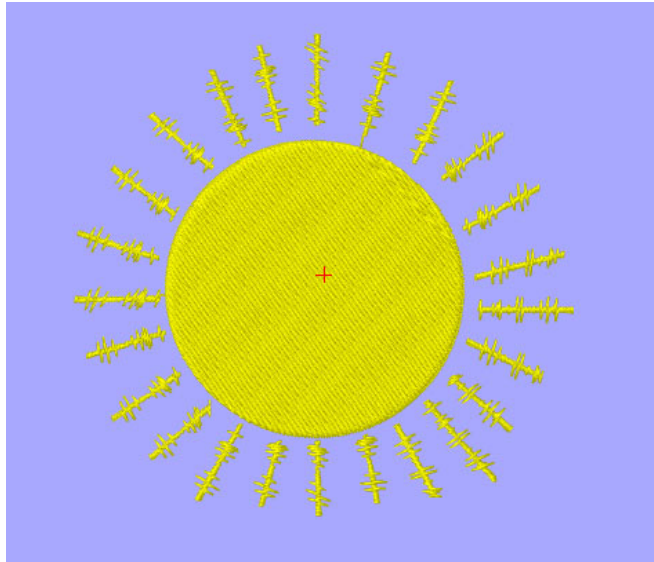

Getting Started

Adjustments: Feathered Satin

1. Open autodigitizing, or click New Design  to get a blank screen if autodigitizing is already open.
2. Set Display Preferences, selecting hoop size for a 225mm design, horizontal.
3. Click the Insert Image  icon. Insert C:/autodigitizing/artwork/Sun
4. Leave all Shape Depiction settings at default and click OK.
5. In the Resize box, set width to 98 mm. Click OK.
6. Generate Stitches.
7. Left click the spool to select all objects with a running outline.
8. While holding the Ctrl key, right click the sun shape at the center of the design to deselect it.
9. Open the Area Properties  sheet.
10. Select the circle beside Column.
11. Place a check in the box beside Feathered Satin. The default settings will appear in the right side of the Area Properties box.
12. Place a check in Enable Side 1 and Enable Side 2. Under each, set Inside to 6 and Outside to 2.
13. Generate stitches. Click the 3D  icon to view the changes.
14. Reopen the Area Properties sheet. Click on the words for Feathered Satin to make the settings pop up in the display.



15. Try changing whether you use Side 1 or Side 2, and vary the settings on the Inside and Outside.
16. Generate.
17. Keep changing the settings until you find a Feathered Satin look you like.
18. Save the Feathered Satin settings as you did the Motif, with the Save icon at the bottom of the Area Property Sheet. This setting will be available to load and reuse in another design.
