


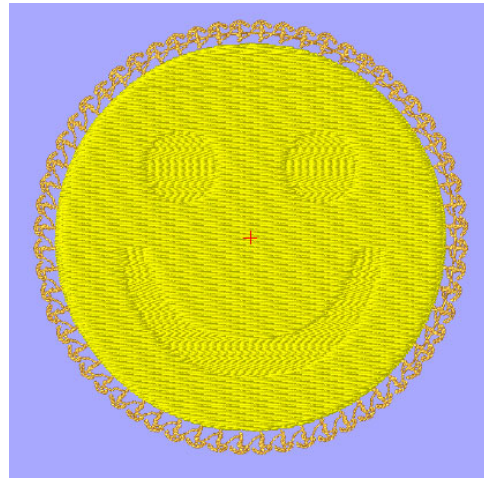


Getting Started





Exercise: Fill Embossing

1. Open autodigitizing, or click New Design  to get a blank screen if autodigitizing is already open.
2. Set Display Preferences.
3. Click the Insert Image  icon. Select the Sun image.
4. In the Shape Depiction window, leave all settings at default.
5. In Resize, set size to 100 mm High. Click OK to accept.
6. DO NOT GENERATE!
7. Zoom All.
8. Right click to select the center of the sun.
9. Open the Area Properties  sheet.
10. Right click beside Complex fill, and change the angle to 180. Leave at the default flat fill. Click Generate.



NOTE: Because the area is selected, only the center section of the sun will have stitches generated. If you had deselected, all the areas on the screen would have generated, rather than just the circle.

11. From the Default/Quick Change tool bar, select the Embossing  icon.
12. Click the Insert True Type Font Border  icon.
13. In the Insert Text properties sheet, select the Wingdings font for Style, place a check beside Bold, and select 50.80 for Size.
14. Left click in the Characters box. Hold the shift key and type the letter J. A smiley face will appear.

15. Click OK and the Smiley Face will appear in outline form and with select boxes around it. Click+hold within the design area to drag the smiley face until it is centered over the yellow circular fill.
16. Right click the Smiley Face to select it with a pink outline.
17. Select the properties tab and click in the circle beside Raised. Click OK to accept the settings.
18. Click the Apply/Exit  icon.
19. Select 3D  view to see the embossing.
20. Click the Outline View  icon.
21. Select Outline/Form Line from Area Border.
22. Apply to Outside Border, change offset to 1.5, and leave Stitch Type at Run. Click OK.
23. Open the Line Properties  sheet. Select Motif Run.
24. Select the Anchor motif pattern, and change angle to 0. Change the color to orange. Leave other settings at default.
25. Click Generate to select the changes.
26. Save the file as SmileyFace.
27. Export as SmileyFace.
