
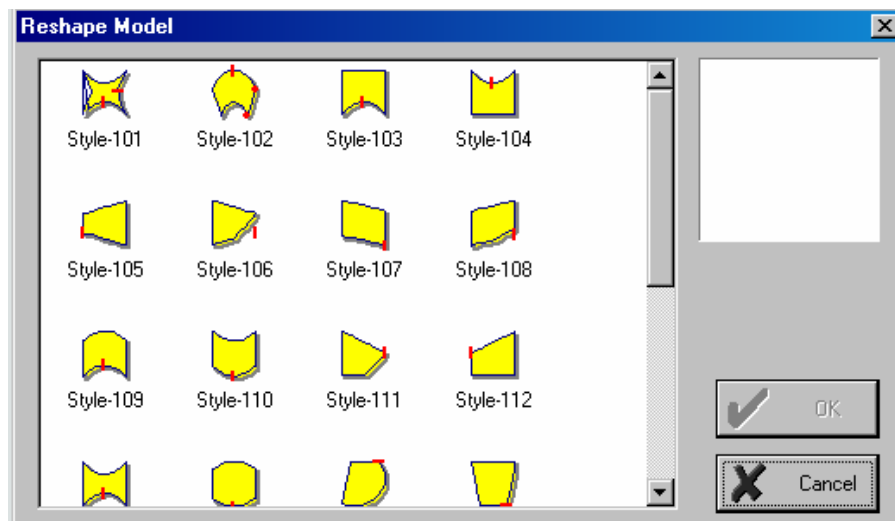

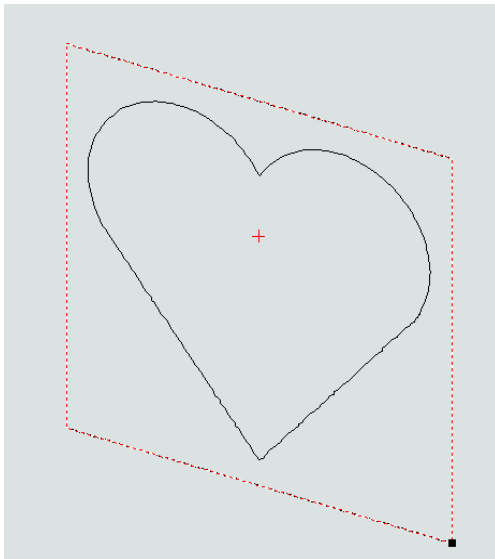
Getting Started

Country Heart: Reshaping a Design

1. Open autodigitizing, or click New Design  to get a blank screen if autodigitizing is already open.
2. Select the Insert Image icon. Select the Hearts image.
3. Click Insert.
4. Leave all settings at the default in the Shape Depiction window. Click OK to accept settings.
5. Set width at 75 in Resize. Leave Ratio Proportions checked.
6. Click OK to accept.
7. Generate stitches.
8. The design will be selected on the screen.
9. Zoom out a few times to make more of the display screen visible around the heart, as you are going to enlarge it as well as reshape.
10. Choose Edit/Reshape (or use Ctrl+R on the keyboard) and a Reshape Model dialogue box will open.
11. Styles 105 to 131 may be selected to use as a model for reshaping the selected object. Select Style 107 and click OK.



12. A Red flag appears in the corner that will be used to drag the object into its new shape.



13. Click+hold the black box at the lower edge of the design to drag the heart in a downward motion, creating a new, skewed shape. (You may also drag the heart up to make it smaller.)

14. When the heart is reshaped, press the Enter key to close the Reshape Option.

15. Generate Stitches.

16. Save as CountryHeart.

17. Export as CountryHeart.
