



## HUSKYLOCK CLUB Inspira Tablet Cover

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### Supply List:

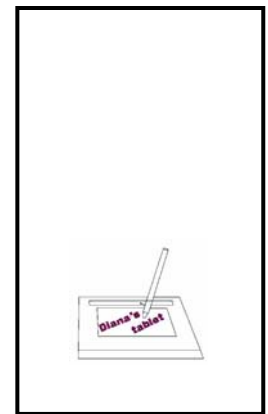
- 24" x 11" of a medium to heavy weight woven fabric
- 24" x 11" of a 100% cotton fabric
- One cone of serger thread
- 2 spools of Sulky 12 wt. thread (for the cover edges)
- 1 spool of Sulky Rayon 40 wt. for the embroidery.
- Bobbin Thread
- Sewing thread and bobbin to match the fabric
- Double Eyed Needle
- Sulky KK 2000 temporary spray adhesive
- Sticky tear away for the embroidery
- Inspira Sketch Tablet



**Note:** If you are using a medium weight woven for the fashion side you will need to stabilize the fabric with an iron on fusible interfacing.

### Embroidery

1. Make a mark on the right side of the fashion fabric about 4" from one short end. Center it between the long edges.
2. Download the tablet design if desired from [www.husqvarnaviking.com](http://www.husqvarnaviking.com), free designs. Personalize it in your Embroidery Software.
3. Hoop the sticky tear away stabilizer.
4. Stick the fashion fabric to the stabilizer.
5. The embroidery should center over the mark.
6. Fix baste the fabric to the stabilizer in the hoop.
7. Embroider the design.
8. Remove the embroidered fabric from the hoop, and tear away what you can of the stabilizer.



**Serger set up:** Set Sewing Advisor for 3 Thread Wide Overlock, Woven Medium. Thread upper and lower loopers with Sulky 12 wt thread. Thread needle with all purpose cone thread. Set stitch length to 1.0. Adjust tensions if necessary for beautiful satin edge look.

Set stitch Width 7.0

### Serge:

1. Spray baste the fashion and lining fabrics wrong sides together.
2. Serge around all the four edges of the rectangle.
3. Bury the tails with a Double Eyed Needle.

### Sew:

1. Fold up the bottom edge 7" (not the embroidered end) to the lining side to form a pocket and pin in place.
2. Beginning at the top edge of the pocket and ending at the fold (A), mark a line parallel to the long edge, measuring in 1 1/2" on one side of the pocket.
3. Straight stitch along this line (it forms the pocket for the pen).
4. Straight stitch down both outside edges of the pocket. Use the inside serged edge as your guide. (B)
5. Insert your tablet and pen, fold over flap and you are ready to go to class!
