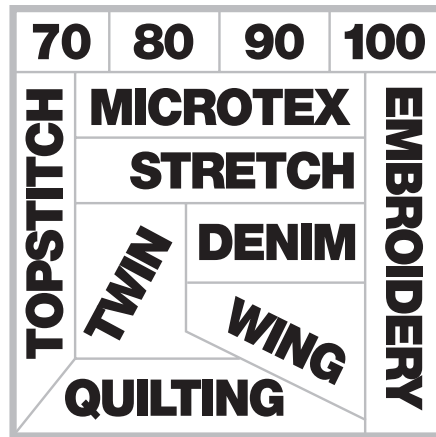
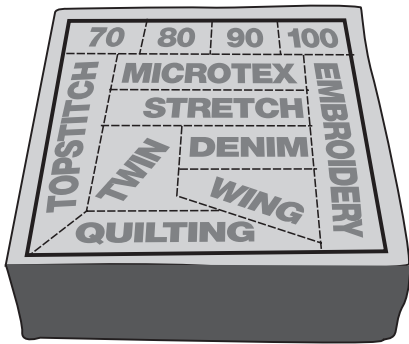


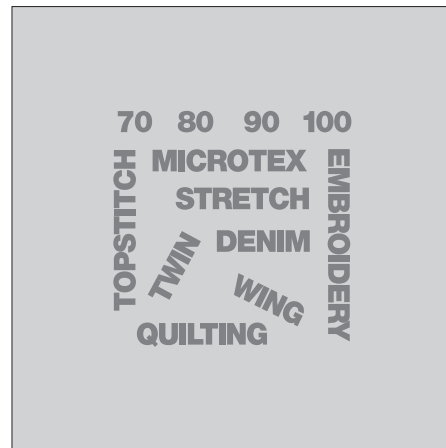
## Needle Cushion

### Embroider

Slide on the embroidery unit. Thread your sewing machine with embroidery thread on top and bobbin thread in the bobbin. Hoop the fabric with Tear-A-Way™ Stabilizer underneath. Embroider. Tear away the stabilizer.



### Cut

Cut the embroidered piece 6" x 6" (15 x 15 cm). Cut the bottom piece the same size. Cut the side piece 4" x 20" (9.5 cm x 51 cm).

### Sew

Mark lines between the words you have embroidered to outline areas for your different needles. Rethread for your different needles with one word in each field. Rethread your sewing machine with sewing thread on top and in the bobbin. Snap on presser foot A. Sew on your marked lines with a favorite stitch. We used the reinforced straight stitch. Sew a frame around the embroidery with a narrow zig zag or decorative stitch. Sew the side piece end to end, right sides. Press. Sew the embroidered piece onto the side piece right sides together. Repeat with the bottom piece but leave an opening. Turn right side out. Press. Fill the needle cushion with fiber fill and close the opening by hand.



### Sewing Supplies

- Husqvarna Viking Sewing/ Embroidery machine
- Heavy cotton fabric, amount; 18" x 22" (45 x 55 cm)
- Fiberfill
- 40 wt. embroidery thread
- Sewing thread
- Pictogram Pen
- Needle for hand sewing

3/8" (1 cm) seam allowance included in all measurements.

The size of the finished Needle Cushion is 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" (12 cm x 12 cm) and 3" (7.5 cm) high. Create your Needle Cushion lettering in the 3D Embroidery Software Program. Select the 100 x 100 hoop size. Choose a font (we used block) and design the words and numbers any way you like. See illustration for ideas.
