



Simple Scarf

You do not have to have perfect sewing skills to make a trendy scarf. All you need is a creative idea and a basic sewing machine to turn a spindle of yarn into a fashionable creation.

Supplies:

- 1 skein of yarn
- 1 spool of strong sewing thread
- A basic sewing machine

- 1.) After picking out yarn for your scarf, you must decide how long you would like to make it. Place the yarn around your neck and measure and mark the length as desired. Once you have determined this length, fold the rest of the yarn over top of itself, making a long, loose rope.
- 2.) With this long, loose rope, choose three areas on the scarf you would like to sew in order to hold the yarn together.
- 3.) Place a rubber band around each area not only to remember where you are going to sew, but also to hold the yarn while you are sewing.
- 4.) Remove the rubber band from the first area and place the yarn under the foot of the sewing machine, holding it taut. With the foot lowered, sew in a straight line down all strands of the yarn. When you reach the end of the first line of stitching, turn the scarf and sew down the yarn in the opposite direction.
- 5.) Sew as many lines of stitches as you would like. Somewhere between 7 and 11 lines is best. Repeat on all three areas, making sure to tightly pull the yarn when you are sewing.
