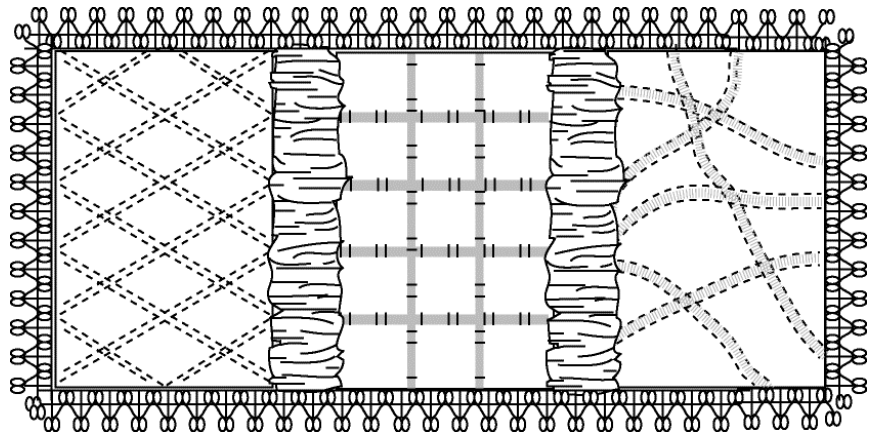


Huskylock Technique Table Runner

This great table runner will not only be a beautiful addition to your décor, but you will learn new techniques on each section, as you sew it.



Supplies:

- Husqvarna Viking Huskylock 936
- Husqvarna Viking Gathering Foot #2141002-502
- Husqvarna Viking Clear Coverstitch Foot #411000098
- Husqvarna Viking Coverstitch Pintuck Foot and guide #412716245
- Husqvarna Viking Cording/ Piping Foot and guide #750.750A)
- Husqvarna Viking Multi-purpose Foot

- 1 1/4 yards white or white-on-white fabric
- 3 spools serger thread to match
- Decorative thread for coverstitch (YLI pearl crown, etc)
- Two Sulky 12 wt. threads or Superior Perfect Quilter to match
- Double eyed needle
- Schmetz Topstitch 90/14 needles
- 4 yards cording (1/16" or 1/8")
- 4 yards Edge lace with header (flat not gathered)
- 2 1/2 yards 1/8" ribbon
- Chalk O Liner
- Omnigrd ruler
- Basic sewing supplies: scissors, tweezers, tape measure, pins
- Serger accessories

Cut:

- Three 12"x 21" rectangles
- Two 4" x 44" strips
- Save scraps for samples

Construction:

Label 12" x 21" rectangle sections of fabric 1, 2 and 3.

Gathered Sections

Huskylock Setup: 4 thread overlock; medium woven on sewing advisor. Long stitch length (4.0 -5.0), differential set at 2.0 , and increased needle tension, gathering foot.

Take each 4" x 44" strip and gather on both sides, set aside. OR set aside the two long strips to gather and attach to rectangle sections later.

Section 1 - Pintucks

Huskylock setup: Narrow coverstitch on Sewing Advisor, Pintuck foot and guide. Mark section 1 with diagonal lines. Place 1/16" or 1/8" cording inside guide and under foot. Using narrow coverstitch, stitch along marked lines and set aside.

Section 2- Flatlock

Huskylock setup: 2 thread flatlock on Sewing Advisor, 12 weight Sulky thread in left needle, use topstitch needle, multipurpose foot. Adjust tensions as needed for heavier thread in needle to achieve a balanced stitch.

Mark horizontal and vertical lines on section 2. With wrong sides together, flatlock along marked lines. With double eyed needle thread ribbon thru flatlock ladder stitches.(ladders should be on right side). Set aside.

Section 3 - Coverstitch

Huskylock setup: Wide coverstitch on Sewing Advisor, decorative thread in looper. Adjust tension as needed for decorative thread.

With wrong side up, serge abstract lines on section 3. Set section aside.

Gathered Sections

Huskylock setup: 3 or 4 thread overlock, , tensions as advised by Sewing Advisor except for needle – tighten to 8, adjust differential to 2.0, and lengthen stitch, use gathering foot.

Take a long strip and place beneath the foot. Take one side of section 1 and place thru slot on gathering foot up to needles. Stitch, gathering and attaching at the same time. Repeat for the adjacent side and next two sections.

OR

Setup Huskylock for gathering as stated above.

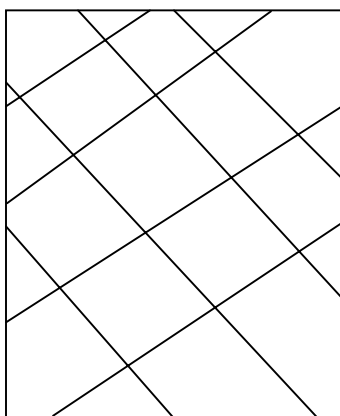
Take gathered strip and place between sections 1 and 2, serge together. Take 2nd gathered strip and place between sections 2 and 3, serge and gather together.

Outer Lace:

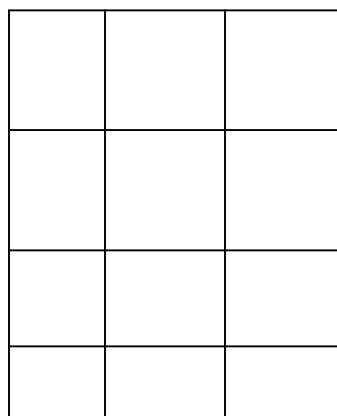
Huskylock setup: 3 thread rolled edge on Sewing Advisor; stitch length 1.3 – 1.5.

Test sample of lace and fabric for a balanced stitch.

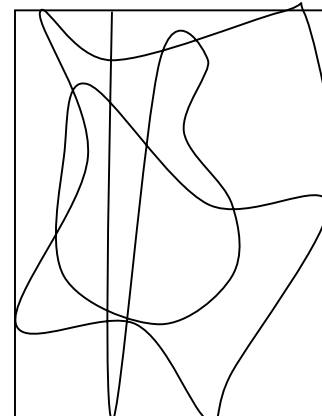
With approximately 1/8" fabric past lace edge, and lace edge under "wall" of foot, serge lace to edge of fabric on all four sides, mitering corners.
