

HUSKYLOCK CLUB

Triple Edged Borders

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This fun placemat is perfect for the upcoming Holidays. Choose a motif fabric for the center and a pretty border fabric and you are ready to go!



Supply List for one placemat:

- Base fabric 21" x 15" (one rectangle per placemat)
- 6 strips of the base fabric $\frac{3}{4}$ " x fabric width (42")
- Insert fabric 18" x 12"
- Warm & Natural batting 18" x 12"
- Steam a Seam $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide x 2 yards
- 3 different color spools of decorative thread (Sulky 12wt Blendable or similar decorative thread)
- 2 Cones of serger thread to coordinate with each of the decorative threads (6 cones in total)
- All purpose sewing thread and bobbin to match the base fabric
- Quick Easy Mitered Binding Tool #140 001171

Serger set up: 3 thread overlock according to the Sewing Advisor with decorative thread in upper looper.

All purpose thread in the left needle and lower looper.

1. On the base fabric, serge with the fabric right side up around all the four sides.
2. Change to another color of thread.
3. Place a $\frac{3}{4}$ " strip under the serged edge, half of it should extend beyond the serged edge as shown.
4. Serge so that the needle goes into the right edge of the previous stitching. Some of the strip will be cut off.
5. Repeat around all the remaining three sides.



6. Change to another color of thread.
7. Repeat for all the edges.
8. You will now have 3 stripes going around all the outside edges.
9. Center the insert on the wrong side of the base fabric.
10. Use the Quick Easy Mitered Binding Tool to mark the sewing lines for the corners.
11. Remove the insert.
12. Fold the corners as per the instructions for the Binding Tool.
13. Straight stitch on your sewing machine on the marked line.
14. Trim seam to a 1/4" and finger press open.
15. Turn right side out.
16. Put fabric insert and batting into the base fabric frame.
17. Place 1/4" Steam A Seam along the inside edge of the frame.
18. Press in place.
19. Topstitch using your sewing machine, along decorative serged edge.
