



Peek-A-Boo T

Nothing beats being able to use an old shirt over again! Try this quick project for the eternal t-shirt.

Supplies:

- 2 shirts, t-shirts or tank tops
 - Water Soluble Marking Pen
 - Scissors
 - Sewing thread to coordinate with shirt combination
- 1.) Begin with two shirts. Sleeve length should not be a consideration. One shirt will be going under the other in the end. The slashed shirt should be solid or with very little activity on the front.
 - 2.) Put both shirts on deciding which one will go on top and which will go on the bottom. Have a friend help you mark your slash lines on the top shirt with a Water Soluble Pen.
 - 3.) Take shirts off and cut the one with the lines. Stretch the t-shirt in the direction of the cuts. This will cause them to ripple slightly.
 - 4.) Set your machine for a narrow zigzag and use regular sewing thread in a color that will compliment the shirt combination.
 - 5.) Zigzag the edges of all your slashes to keep the t-shirt from fraying or tearing further.
 - 6.) Layer up! Try swapping out different slash designs with different underneath tees for an even more original look!
