

Wine Pocket Pouch

This fun wine pouch is the perfect hostess gift! Just add a bottle of wine and you will have a great gift for the hostess with the mostest! It uses the May 2009 Monthly Design.

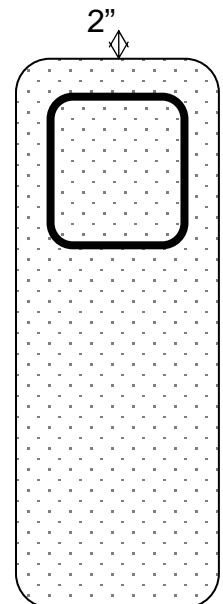
Sewing Supplies:

- 100% Cotton or Lightweight to Medium Weight Denim 36" Long x 11" Wide
- Cotton Print Lining Cut the Same Size
- Steam-A-Seam 2 (enough for the 36" x 11" rectangles of fabric)
- 6" square of INSPIRA® Tear-A-Way Stabilizer
- Robison Anton 40 wt. Embroidery Thread
- 4 Cones of Robison Anton Serger Thread



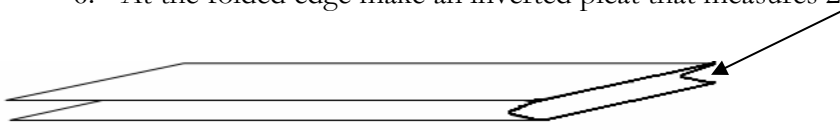
Embroider:

1. Fuse the two fabrics wrong sides together with Steam-A-Seam 2.
2. Hoop the fused fabrics denim side up in the 240mm x 150mm Large Hoop. There is no need for stabilizer.
3. The top short edge of the denim should extend 2" outside the hoop.
4. The bobbin thread should match the last color (the hole). Our sample used purple for the last color.
5. Embroider the design.
6. When your machine stops during the 3rd color trim away the inside of the circle.
7. Take the piece of Tear-A-Way stabilizer that is larger than the hole.
8. Place it under the hoop where the hole is cut out, and start the embroidery.
9. It is not necessary to change threads between numbers 3 and 4.
10. When the embroidery is finished remove the fabric from the hoop.
11. Remove the Tear-A-Way stabilizer.



Huskylock Set Up:

1. Set for 4 Thread Overlock according to your Sewing Advisor.
2. Thread with Robison Anton Cone thread.
3. Trim the rectangle to measure $32\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$.
4. The top of the hole should be 2'' from the top cut edge.
5. Fold the rectangle right sides together.
6. At the folded edge make an inverted pleat that measures 2''.



7. Serge around the 3 sides keeping the pleat in place.
8. Turn right side out through the hole.
9. Place your wine bottle in the pouch.
