

Lollipop Flowers

Sewing Supplies:

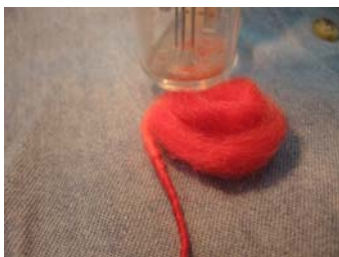
- Huskystar ER10 Needle Felting Machine
- Husqvarna Viking Sewing Machine
- Fab-U-Motion with Stitch Regulator by Cruise Control
- Sulky 30 wt. Blendable Thread
- Size 90 Topstitch Needle
- Denim Garment or Tote Bag
- Flower Color “Thick and Thin” Yarn
- Green Yarn or Roving
- Yellow Yarn or Roving for Center
- Variegated Leaf/stem Yarn
- Open Toe Free Motion Spring Foot #413037645



1. Begin by cutting off three pieces of yarn for each flower. Each piece needs to be both thick and thin.



2. Coil the thick part into a circle and place under the needles of your ER10 Needle Felting Machine. Felt it in place. Don't felt the “thin” part yet. This is the first petal.



3. Place the other two petals and felt in place.
4. Twist the “thin” pieces together and felt in place as a stem.
5. Cut 1 1/2” to 2” segments of green yarn.



6. Fold in half to form a leaf. Place next to the stem and felt in place.



7. Make a small “ball” of yellow yarn or roving and place in the center of each flower. Felt in place.



8. Are you having fun? Let’s take it one step beyond.
9. Make flowers as above but without the leaves and centers.
10. Using a variegated yarn, make a coil and place it next to the flower.



11. Cut so there is a tail approximately 4” long. Coil the end, and complete the “leaf”.

12. To add free motion detail, put on the Open Toe Free Motion Spring foot. Insert a size 90 topstitch needle in to your Husqvarna Viking sewing machine. Thread with 30 wt. Sulky Blendable thread on top and bobbin thread in the bobbin. Attach your Fab-U-Motion with Stitch Regulator by Cruise Control. Free motion stitch over the felted lollipop flowers.
