



## Viva Scarf for Women



### **Sewing Supplies**

- Husqvarna Viking Viva Sewing machine
- Silk fabric 12" x 2 2/3 yd (30 x 250 cm)
- Different scraps of fabric, print, solid color, etc.
- Sulky 40 wt. Embroidery Thread
- Sewing thread
- Pictogram pen (412 08 38-48)

Optional:

Edge/Joining Foot (412 28 02-45)

(Read about optional accessories in the Husqvarna Viking Accessory User's Guide.)

**Cut**

Cut out the scarf according to the measurements above. From the scraps cut out petals for the flowers.

**SEW**

Thread your sewing machine with sewing thread matching the fabric on top and in the bobbin. Snap on presser foot A and select stitch 3, the zigzag stitch. Adjust stitch length to 1.5 and stitch width to 1.5. Sew across the short ends 4" (10 cm) from the edge. Remove threads to create a fringe at the ends of the scarf. Tie knots but leave the outer threads until you have sewn the hem as illustrated.

Turn under a double 1/4" (6 mm) hem along the sides. Press. Select stitch 00, the straight stitch. You can use presser foot A or the optional Edge Joining Foot and adjust the needle to the right. Sew the hem.

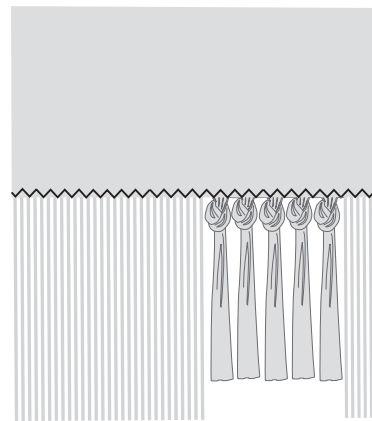

Pin the petals in place to create flowers on the scarf. Draw with a pictogram pen stems and curves. Rethread with embroidery thread on top. Sew the petals in place 1/8" (3 mm) from the edge. Rub the edges so they fray.

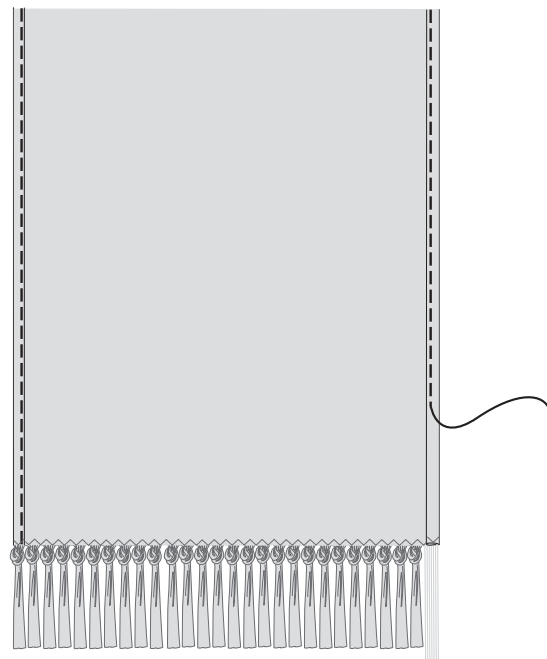

Select stitch 01, the reinforced straight stitch. Sew along the marked lines.
