Create your own unique jacket with the exclusive Designer SE Limited Edition embroideries.

There are lots of design opportunities using the Designer elements, no jacket will be the same. Use mirror image, scaling and resize for even more creative options. You will use the apple tree branch and blossoms embroidery designs over and over again to create a whole collection.



Sewing Supplies

- Burda Pattern 7994
- Beige fabric according to pattern
- Cream lining
- Rayon embroidery thread
- Bobbin thread
- Sewing thread
- Tear away stabilizer
- Stitch and Ditch stabilizer
- Organdy
- Interfacing according to pattern
- Clear Seam Guide Foot #413 03 48-45
- Clear View S-Foot #412 97 51-45
- Velvet ribbon for label
- Buttons

Read through all the instructions before you start to sew.

We have added the lining to the jacket.

Cut

Cut all pieces except the sleeves according to the pattern.

To create the small purse; cut fabric and lining 4 3/8" x 4 3/8" (11 x 11 cm) which includes 6mm (1/4") seam allowance

Embellishment on the body of the jacket

Sew together the jacket front piece (center front and side front pieces) and back (center back and side back pieces) using the Clear Seam Guide foot.

Put together the embroidery elements that you want to embroider. Start with the branch and add the flowers to it. Use resize for variations of the flowers. Once you are happy with your design, save it in My Files. On the back make a combination together with the butterfly and on the front piece use another combination with mirroring and a bug.

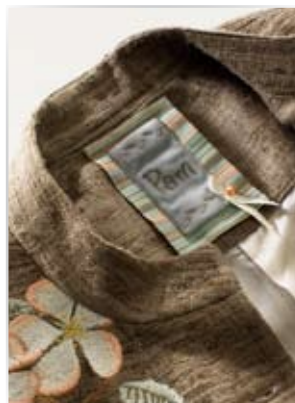
Embroider some 3 dimensional free standing flowers as an added touch on organdy. Cut out. Tack them on using the sew on button program.

Embellishment on the sleeve



Embroider the right sleeve before you cut out the sleeve piece. Use the same embroideries or create a completely new creative combination. Place the pattern over the embroidery to get the correct placement and then cut out the right sleeve.

Label with decorative stitches



Create a label of your choice by using the Meza font or one of the other built-in fonts.

Embroider a name on a piece of velvet ribbon and sew a decorative stitch above and below the name. Place a piece of fabric under the ribbon and sew in place at the top back of the jacket lining

Embellishment on the pocket and purse



Pocket:

Use only the flower and leaf; copy it three times for the embroidery on the pocket.

Place the leaf and flower close together. Resize one or two flowers.

Place the pocket pattern over the embroidery to get the correct placement and

cut out the left pocket.

Add one 3 dimensional free standing flower on top of the combination as an added touch.

Purse:

Embroider a bug on the small purse fabric (1 1/4") 3 cm down from the top edge.

Fold the fabric in half, right side together. Pin and sew the side seam. Square the bottom with a seam 1.5 cm (5/8") from the tip. Repeat for the lining piece but leave a small opening in one of the side seams. Place the two bags into each other right sides together and sew the top edge together. Turn right side out through the lining and sew the small opening.

Sew a buttonhole and button on one top edge.

Decorative stitches on jacket lining



Sew the lining together with the facing, use a decorative stitch to cover the joining edge.

We used stitch M1:11 and 30 weight embroidery thread.

On the lining back piece we used Omnimotion stitch K2:25 to embellish the lining on each side of the back seam. Attach the Clear View S-Foot.



Use 30 weight embroidery thread and Stitch and Ditch tear away stabilizer underneath the seam.

Complete the jacket according to the pattern instructions.
