



Emerald Scarf

What a beautiful scarf to wear at any party!
Use your fantasy to embellish this wonderful scarf with fabrics, lace and ribbons.



Sewing Supplies

- Husqvarna Viking Sewing machine
- 2 1/4 yards (200 cm) of 10" (25 cm) wide grey organza fabric
- Scraps of silk fabrics in different shades of green and grey
- Scraps of green lace
- Green yarn
- 1 1/3 yards (120 cm) of 1/8" (4 mm) wide black Silk ribbon
- 3 1/4 yards (300 cm) of 3/8" (8 mm) wide Organza ribbons in black
- Matching sewing thread
- 40 wt embroidery thread in gold, silver, black and green metallic

CUT

Cut two pieces 80" (200 cm) x 10" (25 cm) of the grey organza fabric.
Cut the silk ribbon, silk fabric and lace into pieces 9 1/2" (24 cm) long and in different width of your choice.
Cut the yarn and the organza ribbon into pieces 20" (50 cm)

Seam allowance 1/4" (6 mm) included.

SEW

Sew the scarf. Thread your Husqvarna Viking Sewing machine with sewing thread on top and in the bobbin. Select straight stitch. Sew front and back pieces together. Place front piece and back piece right sides together and stitch all around. Leave an opening, 4" (10 cm) in the middle of one long side for turning right side out. Turn right side out. Press. Topstitch the opening closed.

Embellish the scarf with the silk and organza ribbons, the silk fabric pieces, the lace and the yarn. Thread your Husqvarna Viking Sewing machine with embroidery thread on top and matching sewing thread in the bobbin. Place the ribbons, fabric pieces, lace and the yarn on top of the front piece and stitch in place. Let the longer ribbons hang loose on each side of the scarf.

Embellish lengthwise on top of the ribbons with different stitches. Use silver and gold embroidery thread.
