



Men's shirt

The exciting part of embroidery is that you can embellish a garment you made from scratch, or personalize a purchased garment. Here is how to embellish a shirt.



Sewing Supplies

- Husqvarna Viking Designer SE
- 30 wt. embroidery thread

Optional Husqvarna Viking Accessories

- Husqvarna Viking 3D Embroidery Studio (920 03 70-26)
- Tear-Away stabilizer™ (141 00 05-43)
- Pictogram Pen (412 08 38-48)

Open 3D Embroidery Studio and open design 9 from Classic Collection in your Embroidery Sampler Booklet. Open the Edit page and remove the flowers. Open the design in 3D Embroidery System and print it out. Transfer the design to your Designer SE.

Trace the design on to the placement template with a template pencil. Place the template on the left side of the shirt and mark the placement with a Pictogram Pen in the holes of the template.

Hoop the shirt with tear away stabilizer underneath. Thread your sewing machine with embroidery thread on top and bobbin thread in the bobbin. Embroider the design.

Mirror image the design end to end and position the next embroidery below the previous one. Embroider again. Tear away the stabilizer.

Cont.

Toggle to Sewing Mode on your Designer SE. Select Woven light on your Sewing Advisor. Rethread with sewing thread matching the top thread in the bobbin. Select stitch A1:14 and sew along the cuffs. Select straight stitch A1:2 and sew on each side of the previous seam.

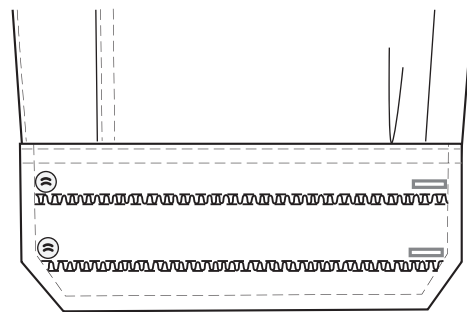
