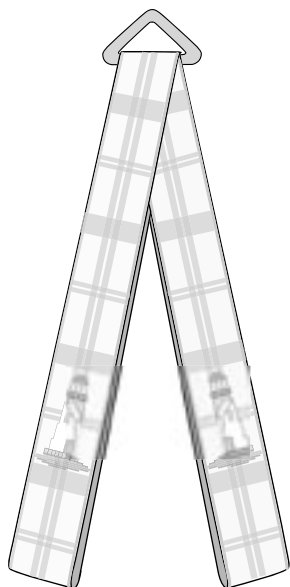


## Tray Holder



### Sewing Supplies

- Husqvarna Viking Sewing & Embroidery machine
- Husqvarna Viking Cross Stitcher software program (412 62 40)
- 2 kitchen towels or white/blue checked fabric
- White sewing thread
- 40 wt. Embroidery thread
- Husqvarna Viking Tear Away™ stabilizer
- 1 wood hanger for tray holder
- Optional Accessories:  
Fasturn tube turner (412 55 08-01)

3/8" (1 cm) seam allowance included in all measurements.

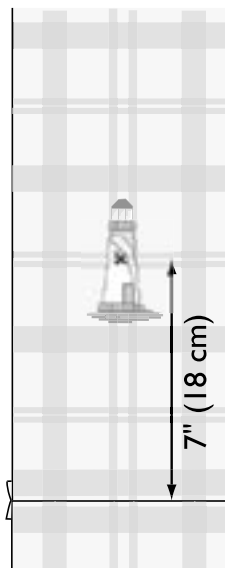
### Cut

If you use kitchen towels, trim away the hem on all sides. Cut 4 strips 6 3/8" x 25 5/8" (16 x 65 cm) from the fabric.

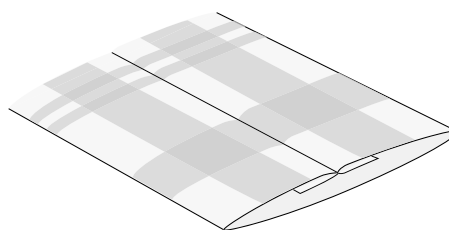
### Embroider & Sew

Snap on presser foot A and select straight stitch. Join the short sides of the strips to make two strips 6 3/8" x 50 3/8" 16 x 128 cm).

Open the light houses from the Cross Stitcher software program. Create stitches and save on a disk or d-Card. Mark the center point for the lighthouses center on the strip, about 7" (18 cm) from the seam. Embroider the lighthouses with tear away stabilizer underneath the fabric.



Fold the strips lengthwise, right sides together and stitch the sides. Turn right side out using a Fasturn tube turner. Press the bands with the seams centered on the backside.



Thread the bands through the wood hanger. Turn under the seam allowance on one side of the band to the inside. Press. Snap on presser foot D. Select left needle position straight stitch. Insert the raw end and stitch the band to a circle. Repeat for the second band.
