



Hat boxes with Embroidered Ribbons

Embroider on Ribbons to embellish hatboxes. The hat embroideries are available on disk/d-Card 115 and 118, Dolls and Clothes by Martha Pullen.



Sewing Supplies

- Husqvarna Viking Sewing/Embroidery Machine
- Huskylock
- 12" (30 cm) pink or blue Chiffon or Organdy at least 43" (110 cm) wide
- 12" (30 cm) white Chiffon or Organdy at least 43" (110 cm) wide
- Sulky 40 wt. Embroidery thread
- Huskylock thread
- Husqvarna Viking Stick-On™ stabilizer
- Hat Box

CUT

Cut two 6" (15 cm) wide strips of white organdy across fabric width and two 6" (15 cm) wide strips of colored organdy across fabric width.

EMBROIDER

Hoop Stick-On stabilizer in the standard hoop with paper side up. Score the paper with a pin so you can pull the paper off the sticky surface. Place the end of the pink or blue organdy strip to the sticky surface. Select a hat design. There are several hats to choose from on Embroidery disk/d-Card 115 or 118 Dolls and Clothes. Embroider one or two hats.

Place the embroidered white organdy with the white organdy wrong sides together. Pin all sides. Set up your Huskylock for rolled hem and finish the edges of the ribbon. (Be careful to not sew over the pins as you sew!). Sew the second ribbon in the same way with or without embroideries.

Cut small holes on each side of the hatbox. Pull in the ends of the ribbon and tie a knot on the inside to fasten them.

Tie a beautiful bow on the lid.
